The move comes in response to 2022 research findings indicating a significant lack of awareness about the Adventist Church in Australia and New Zealand. Only four percent of respondents felt the Church is relevant to their lives, and only 12 percent believed the Church serves those in need. Bridcutt said the Church has a wonderful story to tell, with amazing things happening in schools, healthcare, and local churches. The content is directed for the general public and is in a style and language appropriate for those with limited or no understanding of Christianity or the Bible. GRACE-C is a continuation of the previous missions GRACE and GRACE-FO. GRACE-C is expected to be launched in 2028. Each of these missions is crucial to understand Earth's climate. The partnership between NASA and the German Space Agency will play a critical role in addressing current and future challenges related to Earth's water resources. GRACE-C will be beneficial for our World's economy learning more about climate change, natural hazard, mitigation, wildfire management, and food security.
